The emerging multipolar world order has significantly changed the approach of sovereign states to their economies and industries. Today, leaders are those capable of developing and producing critical technologies and products. This also applies to the shipbuilding industry, which has undergone a significant transformation since 2022. Currently, the domestic shipbuilding industry faces the ambitious task of creating a modern merchant and passenger fleet and replenishing it with new vessels and domestically built marine equipment. Russia's maritime industry encompasses more than just shipbuilding; it also develops waterways that ensure the efficient movement of cargo and passengers within the country and beyond. The implementation of the national project "Efficient Transport System and Modernization of Port Infrastructure" opens up new opportunities for the integration of maritime, river, and rail transport, creating a unified logistics network and strengthening the country's transport sovereignty. During the plenary session, leaders of Russia's maritime industry will answer the most pressing and significant questions, collected in advance from the professional community through a digital survey.
